Here is a list of things to think about as we return to school.

## Uniform

Does it fit?

Does their PE kit fit? Remember the children can come to school in their kit on their PE day

Children do not need to bring in bags unless the class teachers arrange Forest School and they will need a change of clothes.

A - D 8:40am and 2:55pm

E - K 8:45am and 3:00pm

L - Q 8:50am and 3:05pm

R - Z 8:55am and 3:10pm

**Drop off in the morning – allotted time for last name – entrance: main gate – exit: playground gate.**

**Pick up in the afternoon – allotted time for last name - entrance: playground gate – exit: main gate.**

All communication to staff needs to be in an email/Dojo message

Wear a mask onsite

Do not remain on site longer than you need to

Bring in the laptops as soon as you can and put in the porch
